

**Puzzle Name:** Drei Teile Dingsbums (Three Piece Whatsit)

**Designer:** George Bell

**Manufacturer:** Bernhard Schweitzer / New Pelikan workshop

**Classification:** INT-CART

**Material:** Two contrasting woods

**Goal:** Assemble the three pieces into an interlocking, symmetrical solid

**Solution:** The final assembled shape is a cube! Of course, it doesn't look like anything like a normal cube. Strictly speaking, the final shape is eight wood cubes with centers at the vertices of a cube, plus six contrasting wood cubes in the middle of each face. The wood cubes must be tilted in order to join along quarter and half-faces.



To assemble, join two pieces as shown in the diagrams below. The third and final piece is then placed from above, interlocking into the final shape.
